2008 Memorandum of Understanding
Health Canada, FSIN, Ministry of Health

improve First Nations health status

eliminate health disparities

What emerged was the need for:

culturally appropriate health services

competent health services

Strategic direction 1:

Restore First Nations community-based health and wellness systems

Strategic Direction 2:

Establish a “middle ground” for engagement between mainstream and First Nations systems and worldviews

Strategic direction 3:

Transforming mainstream health service delivery to be culturally responsive

Strategic Direction 1:

Revitalize First Nations languages

Teach traditional health practices and medicines

Restore first Nations ceremonies as the source of education and health in First Nations communities

Strategic direction 2:

Building relationships and partnerships between and within First Nations and mainstream health systems

agreements such as Saskatoon Health Region and Saskatoon Tribal Council

establish liaison / navigator/ facilitator type positions

Provincial Center of Excellence – collaboration between western and First Nation traditional approaches to health and wellness

Strategic direction 3:

Foster education in culturally responsive health care

Develop culturally competent and safe policies and programs

Strengthen the First Nations health workforce

Create space in health service delivery for First Nations knowledge and approaches to health and wellness
